Our application process: Return an application to us, and once it is approved, you will be able to meet the pup. If all goes well with the meeting, you have the option of having the pet visit your home to make sure that your family is a match for the dog.

Please Note: WE WILL ONLY ADOPT TO OHIO AND SURROUNDING STATE RESIDENTS, AND YOU MUST BE WILLING TO TRAVEL TO THE COLUMBUS AREA TO MEET THE PET

Things to consider before applying:

Do you have children under the age of 5?

We like to consider the safety issues that arise with the unsupervised contact between young children and new dogs. In any case, we will consider if that dog is a good candidate for a family with small children AND if the parents display “dog smarts” and the experience necessary to introduce an animal in the home. Toddlers are curious and pups never exceed the mentality of a 2 year old, so they do not consider consequences for their actions. Unfortunately, many children have been injured when an animal has tried to play with them, even though the actions of the dog were not vicious; they usually have to pay the consequences (physical abuse, dropped at shelter, abandoned on the street).

We will consider your ability to care for the pet:

Consider how many hours you will physically be with your pet and how long it will be crated during the day. We understand that most people work a normal schedule and the pet will be most likely crated during the day, but we want to know what kind of interaction the animal will have when you get home.

We will consider any physical limitations that you have, and your age now compared to the life expectancy of a dog. Please ask about our “Seniors for Seniors” program

We all understand the lure of a puppy, but please consider an older dog that is already trained! A puppy may not fit your lifestyle and we would love to help find the right fit for you. Also, many pets are abandoned in shelters after their elderly owners are hospitalized or pass on. We will often ask to include the care of your pet in estate planning.

Not sure what you are looking for? Consider fostering! You will help animals find a home while figuring out what personality is the best fit for your home.

It is best to have a small, enclosed fenced area outside for animals to relieve themselves. If you have breed restrictions, they usually permit a specific type of fencing and/or a small fenced area other than fencing the complete yard. If you do not have this type of enclosure, please explain how you will care for the needs of this pet.

Please consider the following:

A physical fence helps protect our pets from harm from people and other animals. Vets tell us that a home with a fenced yard allows their dog to go out more often, avoiding continued Urinary tract infections, which are painful and dangerous. And of course, we want your family safe!

If you have an invisible fence, please consider the following:

- There are too many dogs in the pound with electronic collar
- Children have been bitten while playing with a dog , after it was shocked.
- Dogs have been stolen, injured or killed while within an invisible fence.
- Dogs must NEVER wear a pronged collar.

Most trainers do not recommend invisible fence because it is negative training

Dogs have been affected negatively by malfunctioning training collars, which can cause long term stress issues

Although having an invisible fence is not enough to exclude you from adopting from Cause for Paws, it will help us to determine the right pet for your home. Some of our dogs ABSOLUTELY have to have a physical fence, while others will do well with an invisible fence and proper training.
